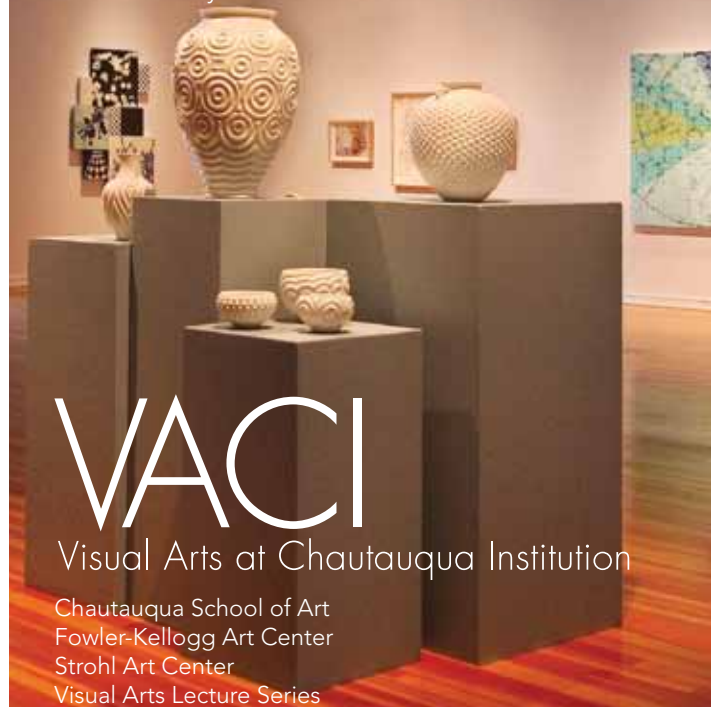

### The Juror:

The juror for the 53rd Annual Exhibition of Contemporary Art is **Kim Foster**, director of Kim Foster Gallery, [www.kimfostergallery.com](http://www.kimfostergallery.com), located at 529 West 20th Street in New York's Chelsea art district. Originally located in Soho, the gallery moved to its present location in 1999. It is a spacious 3,000 square foot first floor space open year-round. Twenty national and international contemporary artists are represented by the gallery with the focus on enabling these artists to explore and to evolve their own work. The Visual Arts at Chautauqua Institution (VACI) is pleased to have Ms. Foster, a distinguished gallerist select this year's exhibition.

### Eligibility:

Open to all artists, accepting all mediums, completed in the last 3 years. Artists must be 18 years of age or older.

### Slide/Image and Entry Form Submission:

Submit 3 slides **or** 8.5" x 11" color printouts **or** photos **or** a CD with JPEGs of your work on it. Files submitted on CDs should be low resolution RGB files saved as a JPG (file names should correspond to titles of works on your registration form). Label slides or images with artist name, title of the work, medium, slide number, dimensions (HxWxD), and year of completion. If submitting slides, indicate the top by placing a dot on the front in the lower left corner of the slide. Non-accepted entries will be returned if a self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) is enclosed. Entry Fee is \$35 (separate from VACI membership dues). Make checks payable to VACI. Fee is nonrefundable. Mail entry form, fee, slides, CDs, color printouts or photographs to: 53rd Chautauqua Annual Exhibition, Box 1098, Chautauqua, NY 14722.

### Work Specification:

Work should be framed and ready for hanging. Framed works must be covered by plexi or acrylic; no glass. 2-D works should not exceed 100 pounds. 3-D work should not exceed 150 pounds. Work that does not follow these guidelines may be refused from the exhibition and returned to the artist.

### Awards:

Awards are given to outstanding works in the Exhibition, as chosen by the Juror. Awards range from \$100-\$1,000; a total of \$2,500 will be given in awards.

### Sales:

All accepted work must be for sale. VACI will retain 50% commission on all sales. The price on the Entry Form will be considered a retail price from which the 50% commission will be deducted in the case of sales.

### Packing and Shipping:

Accepted artists are responsible for the cost of shipping and must pre-pay return shipping. Works must be shipped in REUSABLE packing for return shipping. NO packing peanuts or shredded newspaper. Packing that does not follow these guidelines may be refused from the Exhibition and returned to the artist. Ship packages to: Colonnade Building, 53rd Chautauqua Annual Exhibition, 1 Ames Avenue, Chautauqua, NY 14722 between June 14 and June 18.

### Liability and Agreement

Artwork will be handled with professional care, but VACI cannot be held responsible for loss or damage during shipping. Art will be insured while in the Galleries for the fair market value, indicated on your entry form. Artists must insure their own work during shipping to and from the Galleries. Submitting work to this Exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the artist with all of VACI's conditions. Accepted works may not be removed from the Exhibition before the Exhibition closes. VACI has the right to photograph any accepted work for purposes of publicity.
